The grapple together with all of its moving parts are constructed of hardened steel. The revolving points are designed to ensure holding ability and supreme closing force. The operator has the capacity to deal with all sizes and varieties of supplies using the jaws fitted at the end part of the grapple with toes. This could enable the jaws to be able to close through one another in a finger configuration for utmost handling capacity.
