When this step has been done, all of the components are checked to see if they have any defects, any breakage or any extensive wear. Certain parts like cylinder heads, crankshafts, cylinder blocks and connecting rods are resized, reground and resurfaced if considered necessary. Various parts such as bolts, gears, nuts etc. are repaired or replaced as needed.

Once the overhaul has been done, the engine is rebuilt by hand. After being put back together, a series of tests are applied to the running equipment to be able to check all of the parts and make positive there are no leaks or issues. If any problems occur, the crucial alterations are made.
